

830 Weekend Workshop 2

Both Days:

830 and all accessories including foot control, power cord, Knee Lever (FHS)

Embroidery Module and Large Oval, Mega, and Jumbo hoops

Also Presser Feet #1D, #20D, #37D, #26, #44, #40C and Bernina Stitch Regulator

Scissors

Marking pen/pencil

Ruler, Rotary Cutter and Mat

Bobbin thread - either Bottom Line or Mettler 60 wt. cotton

Embroidery needles - size 90/14

Needles - size 80/12

Surge Protector (not just a power strip)

Other favorite sewing supplies you like/need

Friday:

- 2 pieces of fabric (solid or reads as a solid) 15" x 22"
- Fabric - rectangle 3" x 4" (can be a print)
- A "fussy cut" flower or similar motif from fabric to coordinate with the 15" x 22" fabric
- Isacord or Polysheen embroidery thread - 3 or 4 colors to coordinate with the fabrics
Choose a couple of colors that look good with the fabrics, but that will show up on them when stitched.
- Batting 15" x 22"
- Ultra Clean and Tear stabilizer 15" x 22"
- Aqua Mesh Plus 10" x 15" OR Aqua Mesh 10" x 15" and 505 Spray Adhesive

This project is probably not one you'll actually use or hang on the wall so don't stress about your fabric choices. We'll be playing with some of the neat features of the machine and that's the primary focus of the day.

Saturday:

Go to <http://www.berninausa.com/content-n789-sUS.html> and print the directions for the Endless Embroidery Fan Pillow and the Papillion Pillow. If the link does not work go to www.berninausa.com >the Bernina 8 series > the Bernina 8 series projects and scroll down to the pillow projects.

- We will make the Endless Embroidery Fan Pillow in class and prepare the design for the other pillow so it can be stitched out at a later time.

- Cut the front pillow pieces as instructed in the directions before coming to class. Although the directions call for silk dupioni and decorator fabrics cotton can also be used successfully. If you need more stabilization for the fabric iron a piece of fusible tricot or fusible polymesh on the back. (*See note below)
 - Cut 1 - 15" x 20" fabric for center of pillow
 - Cut 1 - 15" x 20" Ultra Clean and Tear stabilizer (to fit jumbo hoop)
 - Cut 2 - 10" x 20" Ultra Clean and Tear stabilizer (to fit Mega hoop)
 - Cut 2 - 3½" x 15" of the fabric for the side panels
- Isacord or polysheen embroidery thread. You will need six colors to coordinate with your fabric.
